The 624-2 Reservoir has a capacity of 8.1 million gallons.

Crews will work Monday — Friday from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.
- WHO:** Otay Water District and Advance Industrial Services Inc. (AIS).
- WHY:** Recoating reservoirs is standard maintenance that preserves the quality and safety of your water supply by maintaining the integrity of the storage structure. Customers save money over time when routine maintenance is performed on a regular basis.

**Noise and traffic disruptions are not anticipated.** No water service disruptions are expected during the recoating and upgrade work since this pressure zone is also served by the 12-million-gallon 624-1 reservoir. The reservoir will be covered as pictured below.
