This residential project includes Watersmart Edgescaping and Rain-Saving to Gutter and Container Best Management Practices. Mulch and drought-tolerant plants replaced a strip of turf grass adjacent to the street. A cistern and newly installed gutters capture rainwater and reduce runoff to the storm drain system.

PROJECT OUTPUTS

- Area treated:
 - » **3016 sqft** of roof area treated
 - » **437 sqft** of grass removed
- Storage capacity:
3075 gallons of rainwater storage capacity in the cisterns

PROJECT OUTCOMES

- Irrigation runoff reduced:
2,100 gallons/year
- Rainwater prevented from flowing off the property:
11,000 gallons/year
- Nitrogen reductions:
.42 lbs/year
