This residential project features a Rain-Saving to Feature Best Management Practice. A meandering, rock-lined swale, bordered with mulch and drought-tolerant plants, captures rainwater from the roof reducing runoff and mitigating erosion issues.

PROJECT OUTPUTS

- Area treated:
 - » **2111 sqft** of roof area treated
- Storage capacity:
 - 987 gallons** of rainwater storage capacity in the swale, mulch, soil, and drought-tolerant plants

PROJECT OUTCOMES

- Rainwater prevented from flowing off the property:
 - 10,000 gallons/year**
- Nitrogen reductions:
 - .40 lbs/year**
