


## **Private Home**

Escondido, CA 92029

This residential project features a Rain-Saving to Feature Best Management Practice. A meandering, rock-lined swale, bordered with mulch and drought-tolerant plants, captures rainwater from the roof reducing runoff and mitigating erosion issues.





## **PROJECT OUTPUTS**

- Area treated:
- » 2111 sqft of roof area treated
- Storage capacity:

987 gallons of rainwater storage capacity in the swale, mulch, soil, and drought-tolerant plants

## **PROJECT OUTCOMES**

- Rainwater prevented from flowing off the property: 10,000 gallons/year
- Nitrogen reductions: .40 lbs/year







One of the challenges I had on this property was erosion. Through the rebate program, I was able to redirect rainwater from my gutters to a 300-square-foot dry riverbed water feature. I no longer have dirt eroding onto the driveway. It is great to see alignment between this County-offered program and the type of environmental footprint and lifestyle I strive to have.
